- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the only two days of FAST AS WELL AS ABSTINENCE.
- All other Fridays are days of ABSTINENCE only.
- Who is bound to fast? (Ash Wednesday & Good Friday) Those between ages of 18 & 60 years.
- Who is bound to ABSTAIN? Everyone over 14 years. If any eligible person cannot fast or abstain, he/she should substitute an act of piety or charity.

tails of these individuals' lives, until we know them better than friends and family. In conversation, we speak of them as personal acquaintances, when they've never even met us.

Sadly, there are many people today who have the same relationship with God. They use Jesus' name, say all the right phrases, but actually He's never met them. Their "spiritual" life is all on the surface, one-sided, with no real connection to God. Jesus tells us that there will be people who will call out to Him, "Lord did we not prophesy and do great deeds in your name?" But His answer will be, "I never knew you." Today let's focus on developing a two way relationship with God. Asking not "Do I know Jesus?" but instead "Does Jesus know me?"




