those who see with eyes or faith. John's Gospel story of the blind man healed by Jesus invites us to reflect upon the many ways we see and the many ways that we can be blind as well. The good news at the heart of the story shines a light on all our darkness. If we open ourselves to Jesus as our Good Shepherd and Light,



that we can be healed of every blindness, physical and spiritual. Jesus' healing gift empowers us to walk safely in valleys of darkness, His light guiding us on the journey.
